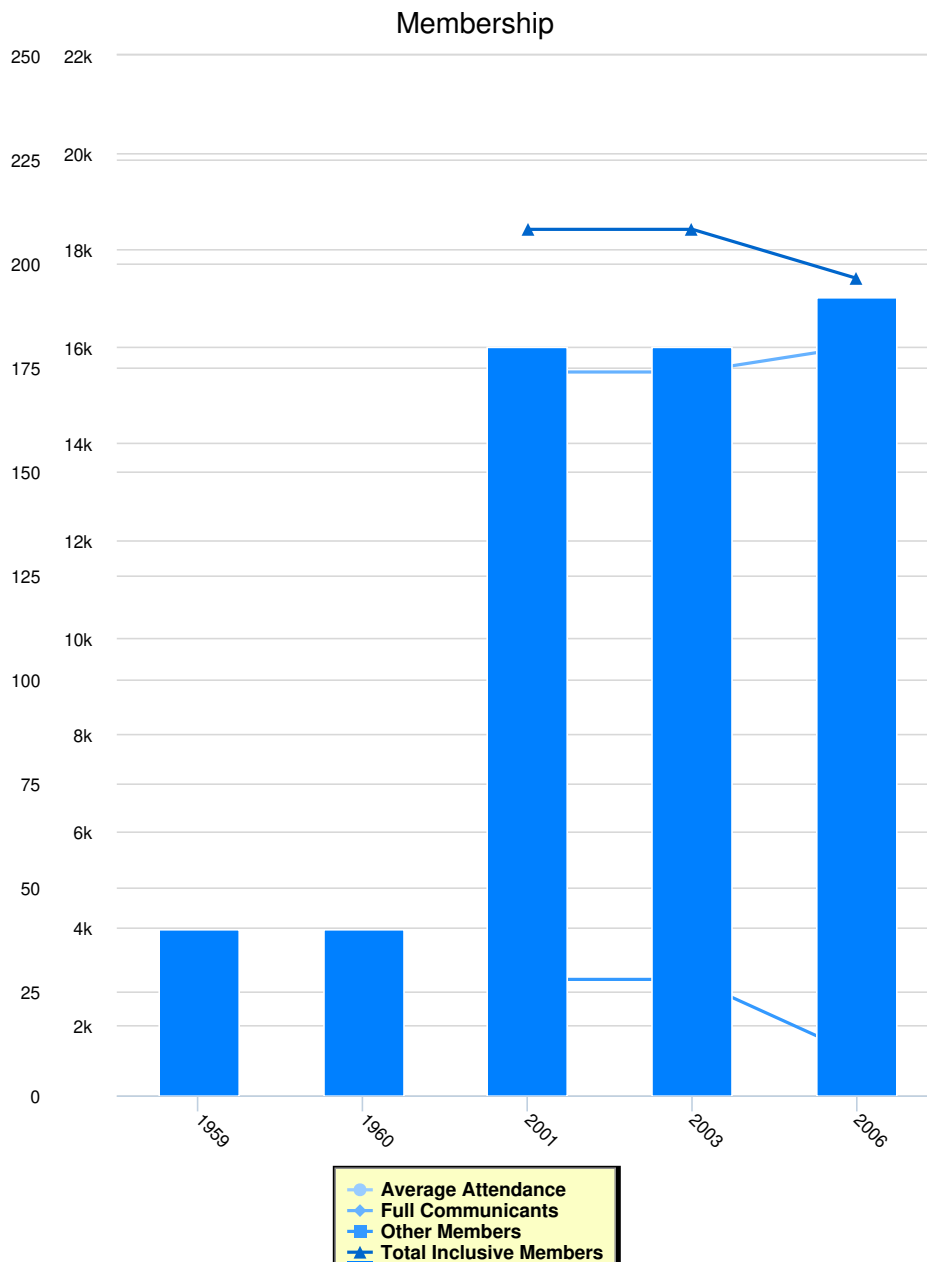

The organization also has ministers in Canada, England, Bolivia, Philippines Thailand, Brazil and South America.



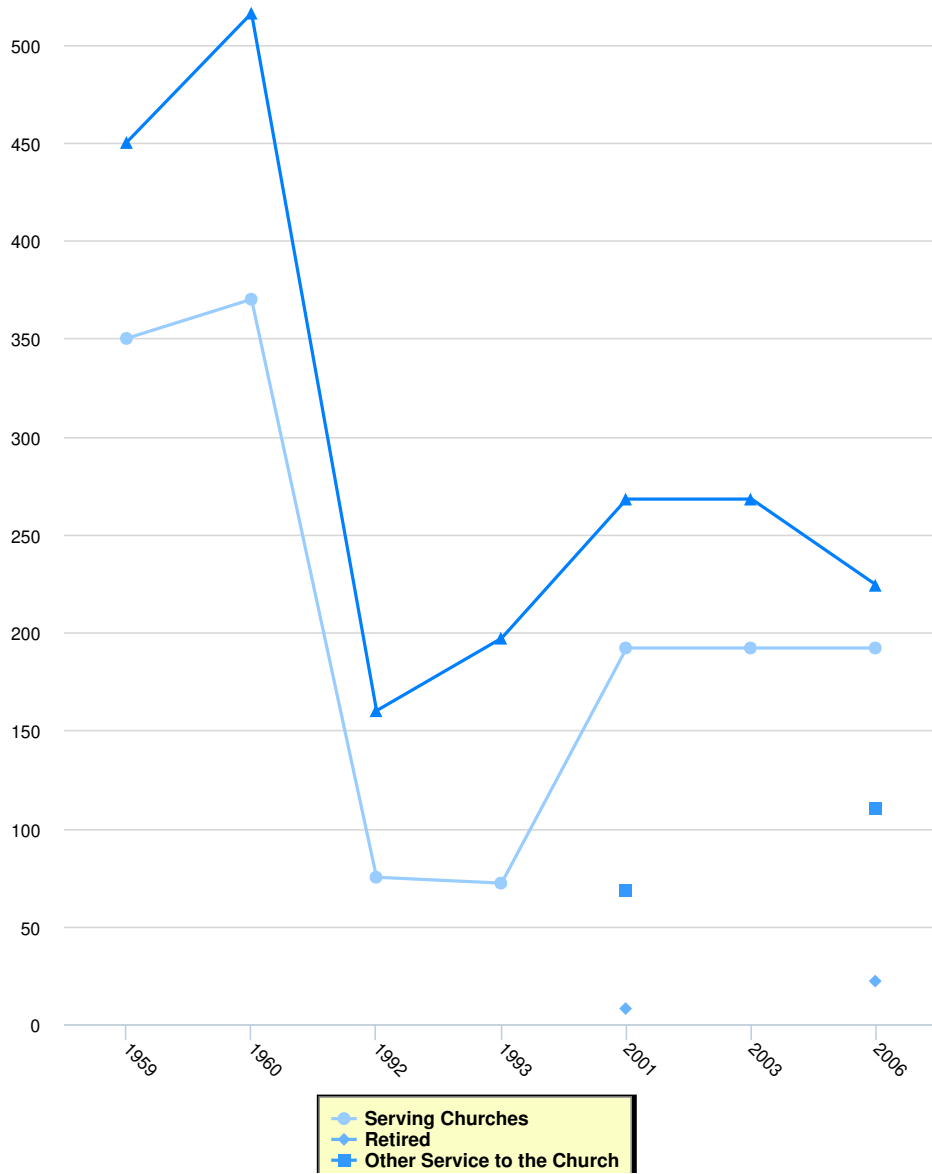

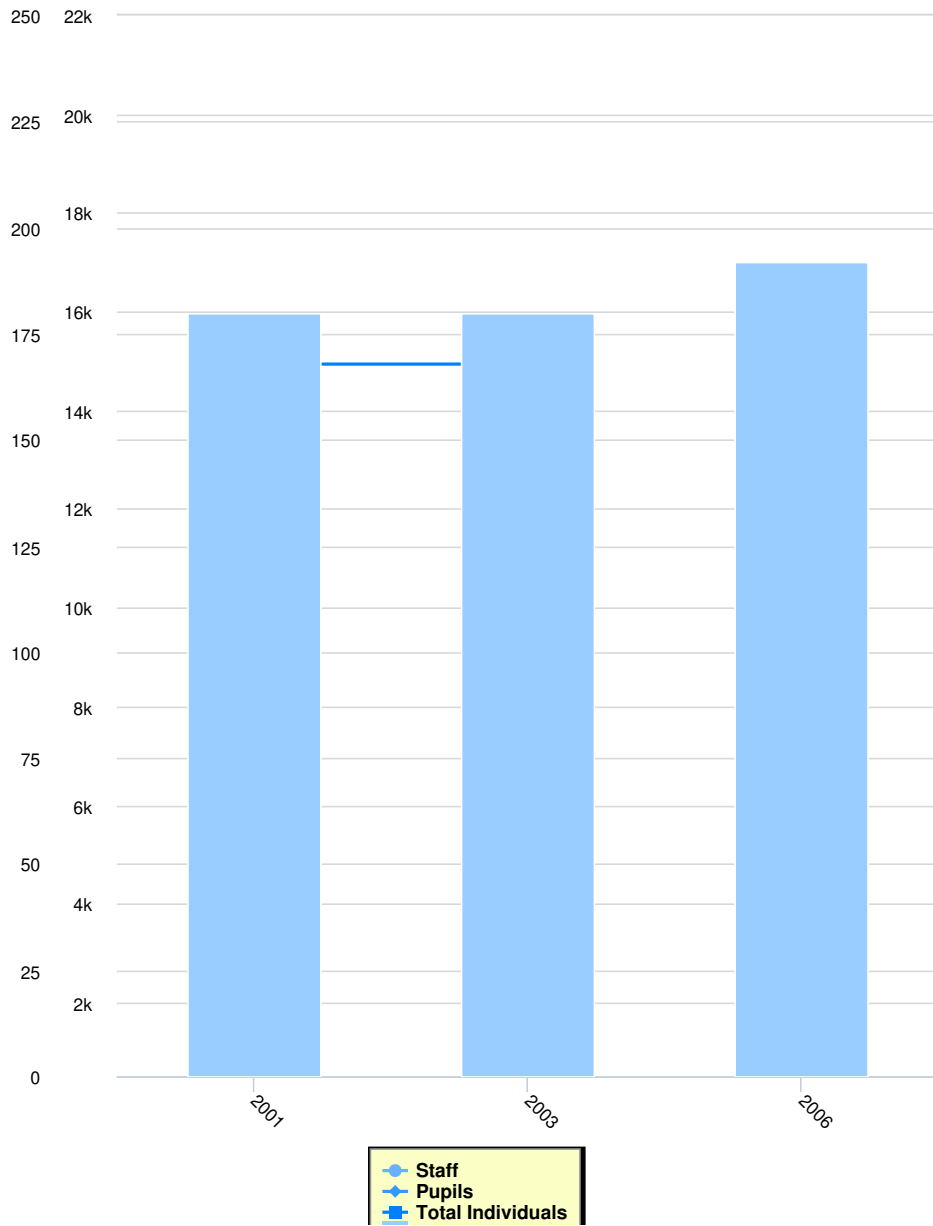

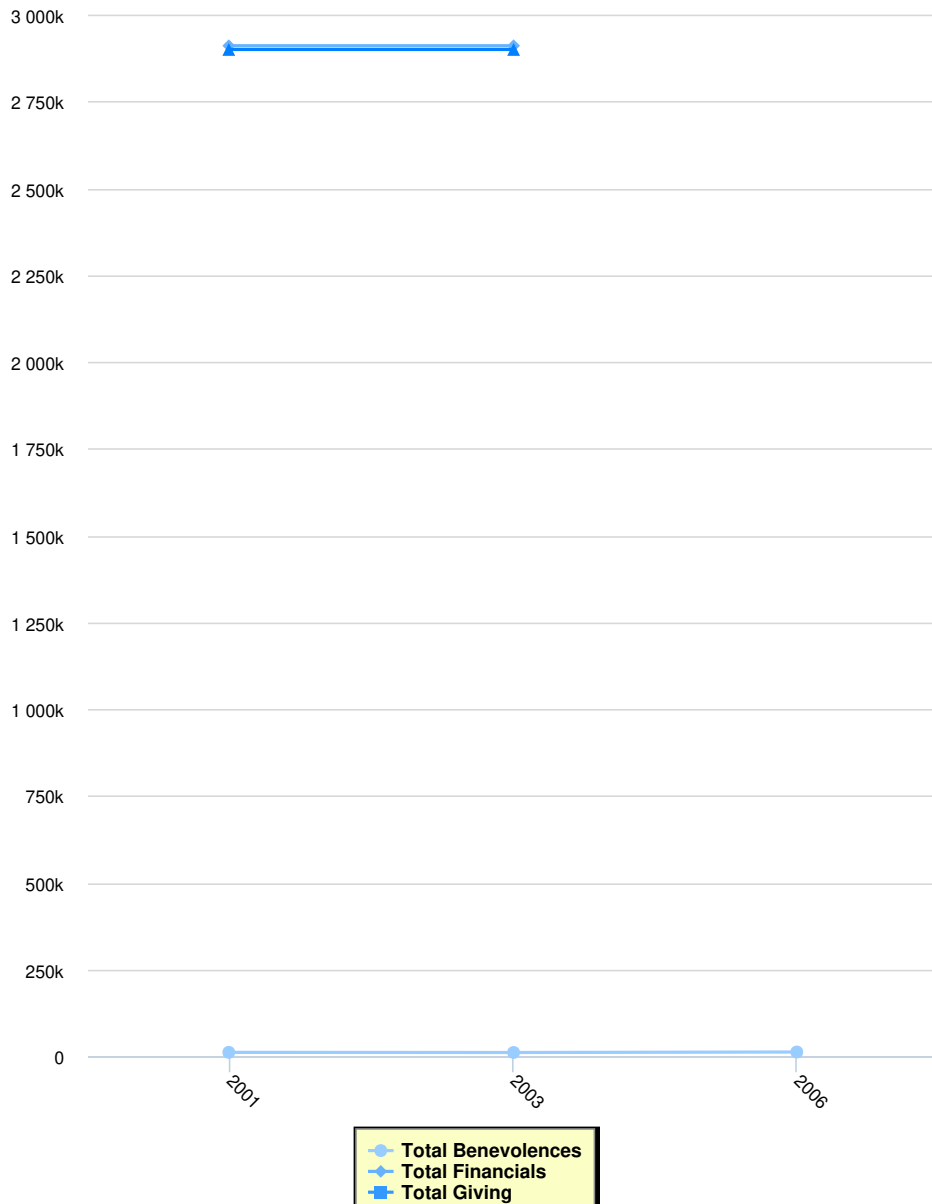
